



Small Business First Program Accepted Certifications List

Below are the accepted certifications under SMCL's Small Business First program. The Small Business First program offers procurement opportunities to small businesses and disabled veteran business enterprises based in California, while providing a streamlined procurement process. SMCL encourages all suppliers to be certified to participate in this program as either a small business or disabled veteran business enterprise.

If your business holds a small business or disabled veteran business enterprise certification from an organization not listed below, contact purchasing@smcl.org to confirm if the certification meets the requirements of this program. Please note that your business must be based in California to qualify.

If your business is an Individual/sole proprietor or single-member LLC based in California, you will not be required to provide a Small Business certification to qualify for the Small Business First program unless the procurement you are awarded exceeds \$15,000 in a single fiscal year or over the term of a contract.
