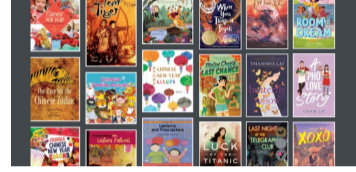

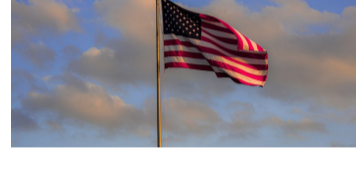

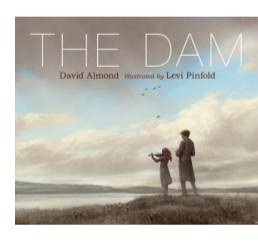
Thursday, February 24 • 7:00 PM

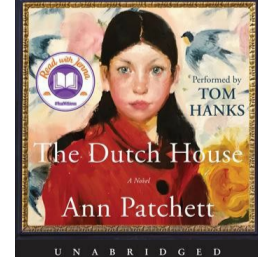

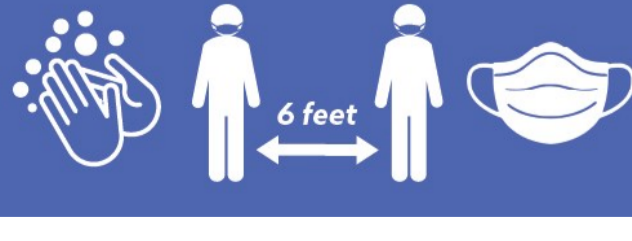


Adult Audiobook: [The Dutch House](#) by [Ann Patchett](#)
