

Young Adult Fiction: [The Phantom Twin](#) by [Lisa Brown](#)

In this dark graphic novel, conjoined twins Jane and Isabel are performers in an early-20th-century carnival sideshow. Sold by their parents to the sideshow manager at the age of 3, the twins are exploited to perform for gawking audiences. The other performers (or "freaks," an insult they have reclaimed) become their family. Now 16, Jane is ambitious and outgoing while Isabel is more appreciative of their carnival support system. When a doctor who aspires to medical fame offers to surgically separate the sisters, Jane jumps at the opportunity to lead a "normal" life. Isabel is less convinced but agrees for her sister's sake.
